

- Please communicate all situations:

- Symptoms: 100.4+ fever, chills, feeling hot, sore throat, cough, headache, stomachache, fatigue, lethargy, diarrhea, vomiting, congestion, and runny nose
- Children often have no symptoms - or very mild symptoms which last less than an hour.
- Close contact:
 - Eating with or being within 6' of a positive person, even if one or both people are masked.
 - Count 48 hours before the positive person took the test/started symptoms (whichever was first).
- Fully vaccinated:
 - Got booster shot 2 weeks to 6 months ago
 - OR completed the Pfizer or Moderna vaccination 2 weeks to 6 months ago
 - OR completed the J&J vaccination 2 weeks to 2 months ago
- Please email the original vaccination card (completely filled out) to the office.

To return to school: follow the chart and have 0 symptoms for 24 hours without meds. If you do not want to test, add 5 days to the return date. We accept any kind of test.

Kindergarten to 5th grade child tested positive	Day 0 = the day the child took the test OR the day the symptoms started (whichever was first)	Stay home. Return on day 6.	Stay home. Return on day 6.
Toddler, preschool or young fives child tested positive	Day 0 = the day the child took the test OR the day the symptoms started (whichever was first)	Stay home. Return on day 11.	Stay home. Return on day 11.
