

Health Policies: What the Students Can Do

- If you feel sick, stay home.
- If you are four years old or older, wear a mask inside.

- Wash your hands:
 - When you arrive
 - When you use the bathroom
 - When you cough or sneeze
 - Before and after you eat

- Eat during snack and lunch time only.
- Eat only the food and drink you bring with you.
- Leave your water bottle on the counter.
- Use only the pencils, pens, scissors, and other items that are assigned to you.
- Use only your computer, charger, and headphones.
- Bring a change of clothes in a plastic bag. Label everything.
- Greet your friends from afar, instead of shaking hands or giving high fives.
- Stand further from people when you talk to them.
- Spread out when you work and play.
