When to Stay Home & When to Return to School

- If the situation arises at home, email our secretary, Annalise, at abuehner@eaglecreekacademy.com and keep your child home. If the situation arises at school, we will contact you to pick up your child within 30 minutes.
- Isolation or quarantine is the number of days the child stays home. Ex.: Close contact on January 1. Count 10 days of isolation or quarantine from January 2 to 11. Return January 12.
- The school may change these guidelines any time.

Child has 1 of these symptoms	100.4+ fever Chills Sore throat Cough Headache Fatigue Diarrhea Stomachache Nausea Vomiting Congestion Runny nose Shortness of breath Difficulty breathing Loss of taste or smell	<p><u>If the child is not vaccinated:</u> ~ No fever for 24 hours without meds ~ AND symptoms improving ~ AND quarantine for 10 days after onset of symptoms</p> <p><u>If the child is not vaccinated, we may allow:</u> ~ No fever for 24 hours without meds ~ AND symptoms improving ~ AND negative PCR COVID test on day 5 or later ~ AND quarantine for 7 days after onset of symptoms</p> <p><u>If the child is fully vaccinated:</u> ~ No fever for 24 hours without meds ~ AND symptoms improving ~ AND negative PCR COVID test on day 5 or later ~ AND quarantine for 7 days after onset of symptoms</p>
Child has close contact with a person who tests positive	Hugging Kissing Eating near Being sneezed on Being coughed on Sharing utensils Being closer than 6 feet for 10+ minutes	<p><u>If the child is not vaccinated:</u> quarantine for 10 days after date of contact</p> <p><u>If the child is fully vaccinated and shows symptoms:</u> quarantine for 10 days after date of contact</p> <p><u>If the child is fully vaccinated and does not show symptoms:</u> stay in school with a mask; get tested on day 5, 6, or 7 after contact and submit the results to the school</p>
Child lives with a person who tests positive		<p><u>If the child is not fully vaccinated:</u> quarantine for that person's 10 days plus another 10 days</p> <p><u>If the child is fully vaccinated and shows symptoms:</u> quarantine for that person's 10 days plus another 10 days</p> <p><u>If the child is fully vaccinated and does not show symptoms:</u> stay in school with a mask; get tested on day 5-7 after first contact and submit the results to the school; get tested on day 15-17 and submit the results</p>

<p>Child tests positive for COVID-19</p>		<p><u>All children, vaccinated or not:</u> ~ No fever for 24 hours without meds ~ AND symptoms improving ~ AND isolate for 10 days after onset of symptoms</p>
<p>Child travels outside the USA to a place the CDC labels risk level 3 or 4</p>	<p>CDC website: https://www.cdc.gov/coronavirus/2019-ncov/travelers/map-and-travel-notices.html</p>	<p><u>If the child is not vaccinated:</u> quarantine 10 days after the day of return</p> <p><u>If the child is fully vaccinated:</u> stay in school with a mask; get tested on day 3, 4, or 5 after the day of return and submit the results to the school</p>
