When to Stay Home & When to Return to School

- If the situation arises at home, email Mrs. Jen VanHowe at jvanhowe@eaglecreekacademy.com and keep your child home.
- If the situation arises at school, the school will contact you to pick up your child within 30 minutes.
- The student may return to school when ALL conditions are met.
- The school may change these guidelines at any time and for any student.

Situation	Description	When Student May Return
Student has any of these symptoms	100.4+ fever chills sore throat headache cough muscle pain diarrhea extreme fatigue shortness of breath loss of taste or smell	1. Doctor's note with diagnosis, statement when child may return to school, and doctor's name with company & phone OR negative COVID-19 test taken on 5th day after the onset of symptoms OR wait 10 days from onset of symptoms 2. Symptoms improving 3. No fever for 24 hours without meds
Sibling of students with above symptoms		The sibling may return at the same time as the student who had the symptoms.
Student tests positive for COVID-19		1. Wait 10 days after symptoms first appeared 2. Doctor's note stating when child may return to school with doctor's name, company & phone 3. Symptoms improving 4. No fever for 24 hrs without meds
Anybody in the family tests positive for it		Wait 14 days after contact with that person.
Student has close contact with a person who tests positive for COVID-19	-- Being within 6' for 15+ minutes of a person who has it -- Touching, kissing, being sneezed on, being coughed on, sharing eating utensils, etc with a person who has it	Wait 14 days after contact with that person.
Student lives with a person who has it		Wait until that person's quarantine has ended then wait 14 more days
