

Health Policies: What Your Family Can Do

- Health
 - Check your child's temperature 30 to 60 minutes before you drop him off each day.
 - If we ask you to pick up your child, pick him up within 30 minutes.
 - Take a look at the document called "When to Stay Home and When to Return" posted on our website: <https://www.eaglecreekacademy.com/health-policies.html>.
 - If your child has a medical condition or allergies, email the school principal and school secretary about it and turn in the appropriate forms.
- Masks
 - Children who are 1 and 2 should not wear masks.
 - Children who are 3+ years old must wear masks:
 - In the parking lot
 - On the sidewalks and porch
 - In the hallways
 - Children who are 12+ years old must also wear masks during class.
 - All adults must wear masks:
 - In the parking lot
 - On the sidewalks and porch
 - In the hallways, office, and classrooms
 - Supply a clean mask for your child every day.
- Drop-off
 - Have only one family member at a time drop off and pick up.
 - You may drop off and pick up preschool, young fives, and kindergarten children at the classroom door. As they become comfortable, we will ask you to drop them off and pick them up at the front door.
 - Children in grades 2 and under enter & exit the front doors.
 - Children in grades 3 to 6 enter & exit the west doors (by the parking lot).
 - If you have children in both categories, they should use the front doors.
 - Consider signing the document giving your child permission to walk out on his own at the end of the school day.
- Entering the building
 - Please do not enter the classrooms for any reason.
 - Please make an appointment to enter the office. Call ahead.
 - To drop off forgotten lunch boxes, books, homework, etc, please label them, put them on the table outside the office, and let the secretary know they are there.
- Separation
 - If you walk past somebody, give that person 6' of clearance, whether you are inside or outside, even with your mask on.
 - Before-care and after-care are available ONLY to children who sign up for the semester.
 - Do not take your child to work for Take Your Child to Work Day.

- Hygiene
 - Do not bring pacifiers to school.
 - Please leave your pets in your car.
 - Have your child use hand sanitizer as soon as he gets in your car after school.
 - Pack food and drinks that your child can open on his own.
